

Circular Crochet Rug

Materials:

Yarn: 5 rolls of T-shirt Yarn (tape yarn or glossy tape yarn)

Hook: L (8 mm) crochet hook or hook specify for the yarn of your choice

Notions: Scissors, Stitch markers (optional)

Gauge & Finished measurements:

Gauge: will vary depending on the T-shirt yarn thickness.

Stitches Used-Abbreviations (US Terminology)

Ch-Chain sc-Single Crochet dc- Double Crochet

Sl st- Slip Stitch fdc- Fake Double Crochet

Special stitches & techniques:

Fake double crochet for first round: pull active loop a little bigger and remove hook, insert hook into 3rd ch of round from back to front, continue with “FDC”.

Fake Double Crochet: pull active loop a little bigger and remove hook, insert hook into 1st dc of round from back to front (Fig. 1). Put active loop on hook and pull through to backside (Fig. 2a and 2b). Remove hook from active loop and insert your finger to hold it in the right place and insert hook from front to back into the same stitch (Fig. 3) yarn over and pull through. Again remove hook from active loop and insert in both loops from back to front (Fig. 4a and 4b), yarn over and pull through both loops (Fig. 5). Ch 1.

Project level: Easy

Notes:

- ~ The second to fourth chains count as the first dc.
- ~ Each round is closed with the “fake double crochet” (see special stitches & techniques). This count as the first dc of the round.
- ~ From 3rd round and on the last stitch will be in the join of previous round.

Pattern

Ch 4

Round 1: Work 11 dc into first ch, work a fake double crochet for first round to join (see special stitches). <12dc>

Round 2: work 1 dc in same stitch, work 2 dc in each stitch around, close round with fake double crochet. <24dc>

Round 3: work 1 dc in same stitch, *1dc in next stitch, 2dc in next stitch; repeat from * around, close round. <36 dc>

Round 4: work 1dc in next stitch *work 2 dc in next st, work 1 dc in next 2 stitches; repeat from * around, work 2dc in last stitch, close round. <48 dc>

Round 5: * 2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 3 stitches; repeat from * around omitting 1 dc in last repeat, close round <60 dc>

Round 6: work 1 dc in same stitch, work 1dc in next 4 stitches, *2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 4 stitches; repeat from * around, close round. <72 dc>

Round 7: work 1 dc in next 4 stitches, * 2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 5 stitches; repeat from * around, close round. <84 dc>

Round 8: work 1 dc in same stitch, work 1dc in next 6 stitches, *2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 6 stitches; repeat from * around, close round. <96 dc>

Round 9: work 1 dc in next 6 stitches, * 2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 7 stitches; repeat from * around, close round. <108 dc>

Round 10: work 1 dc in same stitch, work 1dc in next 6 stitches, *2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 6 stitches; repeat from * around, close round. <120 dc>

Round 11: work 1 dc in next 6 stitches, * 2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 7 stitches; repeat from * around, close round. <132 dc>

Round 12: work 1 dc in same stitch, work 1dc in next 6 stitches, *2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 6 stitches; repeat from * around, close round. <144 dc>

Round 13: work 1 dc in next 6 stitches, * 2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 7 stitches; repeat from * around, close round. <156 dc>

Round 14: work 1 dc in same stitch, work 1dc in next 6 stitches, *2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 6 stitches; repeat from * around, close round. <168 dc>

Round 15: work 1 dc in next 6 stitches, * 2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 7 stitches; repeat from * around, close round. <180 dc>

Round 16: work 1 dc in same stitch, work 1dc in next 6 stitches, *2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 6 stitches; repeat from * around, close round. <192 dc>

Round 17: work 1 dc in next 6 stitches, * 2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 7 stitches; repeat from * around, close round. <204 dc>

Round 18: work 1 dc in same stitch, work 1dc in next 6 stitches, *2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 6 stitches; repeat from * around, close round. <216 dc>

Round 19: work 1 dc in next 6 stitches, * 2 dc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 7 stitches; repeat from * around, close round. <228 dc>

If you wish to make a larger rug, continue working increases by alternating the starting increase.
